42. Flowering house plant	1 plant
43. House plant, grown with bracts	1 plant

45. Any other trailing plant	1 container

SECTION C: DESIGN Theme: "Our Oceans"

Class: All designs to be created without the use of floral foam.

47. "Atlantic Adventure." A Visible use of water design. Note: OJES page 156 - A design that must include water that is clearly visible. Any design in which water is an important component. May be water viewing, underwater etc.
48. "Polynesian Sunrise." A design.
49. "Tidal Pool." A water viewing design. Note: OJES page 156 - A traditional line design, adapted in Canada in the 1960's, with a dominant line of plant material and great use of space, in a shallow container with 1/2 to 2/3 of the container surface showing water.
50. "Caribbean Nights." A design.
51. "Seashells by the Sea Shore." A small design incorporating shells
